- Purpose / Literature review
- Material and Methods: Briefly describe methods implemented throughout the project. List the main stages, the tools and equipment, and dates.
- Results: It is needed to include sufficient evidence to support the results of the project and also to describe in detail the changes identified.
- Conclusions: Findings.
- Literature references in proper unified format.

The deadline for submission of abstracts 31st May 2024.

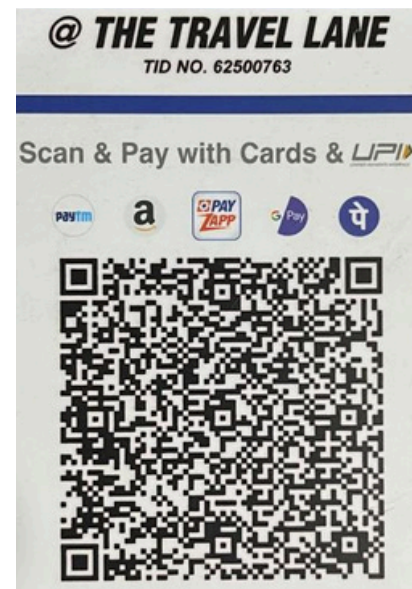
